

HOW DO THEY FIND OUT THAT THE BABY IS BORN?

Let's see... how do you do when you have Slide 2 good news to share, like you managed to do something you couldn't do?

Slide 3 You write a letter or you phone, slide 4 you send an SMS, or an email, and presto! Let's go! slide 5 You say it by jumping, singing or very softly in your ear. Finally you manage to let others know and even more to be as happy as you. That's what you do! Is not it?

Well, we've seen it in our last stories. Many times He sent His messengers from heaven, angels. For example Slide 7 to Zacharias, Slide 8 to Mary, to Joseph, to Slide 9 the shepherds. But He doesn't always do the same, and today we're going to see how He warns Slide 10 an old man and Slide 11 an old lady.

You will can read again Slide 12 this story in the 2nd chapter of the Gospel of Luke.

At the end of the story, you can answer my question: Slide 13 Simeon and Anne, what do they do when they see the baby?

Slide 14 WHO WILL TELL THEM THAT THE BABY IS BORN?

Slide 15 Simeon is an old gentleman who lives in Jerusalem. He loves God with all his heart. He knows that God has promised slide 16 to send a savior to do good for both children and adults. slide 17 He believes it with all his heart and for years and years he has waited for this to happen. He is not discouraged because God made a promise to him slide 18 that he would not die until he saw this promised savior.

Slide 19 One day the Spirit of God Slide 20 prompted him to go to the temple. It is as if, in his heart, he was told:

Slide 21 -Simeon, go to the temple, go to the temple.

Simeon obeys because he knows that God sometimes speaks that way.

Slide 22 As he enters the temple, he sees a young couple arriving with a baby in their arms. They are coming to present their child to the Lord. They are Joseph and Mary.

Simeon does not know them and this baby Marie is carrying has nothing special, but Siide 23 Simeon understands immediately what is going on.

Slide 24 He gently takes the baby in his arms and Slide 25 starts talking to God, praising him. He says:

Slide 26 - My God, now I can die, I can leave in peace with you, Slide 27 because today I see the savior whom you promised. He is the light that will enlighten all nations, all peoples.

Slide 28 Joseph and Marie listen in wonder.

Slide 29 Simeon blesses them then he says strange things to Mary:

Slide 30 - Many people will reject your son, and that will make you suffer. Slide 31 But he will also be the cause of great joy to many others.

Marie does not understand very well but she keeps these words preciously in her memory.

Slide 32 Now here comes an 84 year old lady, slide 33 Anne. She has lived in the temple for years.

Slide 34 When she sees the baby, Slide 35 she starts to praise God loudly because she too understands. Slide 36 The Spirit of God revealed to her that this little child that is there is the promised savior.

She is so happy... Slide 37 finally! He's there. She tells all the people she meets who are also waiting for the savior to come. She says to them:

Slide 38 - You can be happy! You can now rejoice because slide 39 God sent him, he is born, I saw him, he is Jesus. Glory to God who always keeps His promises and who will do good to his people.

Slide 40 Mary and Joseph are in awe of everything they see and hear. God is letting people know to they do not know that Jesus is truly the promised savior. They keep all of these things in their hearts.

Slide 41 After these unforgettable days, they return to their house taking good care of the little child.

But, we will see in our next story that many surprises still await them. So, see you soon on "1,2,3 RACONTE".

Slide 42 1, 2 3, 4 AND YOU AND ME!

Personally, I have never seen an angel. And you have you ever seen? No!

Neither did Simeon and Anne, but slide 43 God did otherwise so that they knew that Jesus was born. It was in their hearts that things happened. Yes, the Spirit of God can warn us, let us know something special, it's for us. God has everything at his disposal, slide 44 he does as he wants with everyone. But the important thing for Him is that slide 45 all men and all children know that slide 46 Jesus came to do them good. And you... well, you know that now.

Slide 47 Tell me, have you noticed what slide 48 Simeon and Anne do when they see Jesus? This is our question. They do like the shepherds; slide 49 they praise God and thank Him. They are in joy.

Slide 50 And you, are you in the joy of knowing that Jesus came to do you good, to bless you?

Slide 51 4, 3, 2, 1 AND WE PARENTS!

Have you ever met any of those old Christians sparkling with joy for the Lord? Despite the pains, failing health, the worries of life, they are still there, slide 52 encouraging, ready to remind you of God's promises? They remind me of Simeon and Anne whose faith in the Word of God has not wavered despite years of waiting.

Slide 53 But where is the secret of their perseverance? Slide 54 How did they understand what the Spirit of God was telling them? Slide 55 What did the coming of Jesus mean to them?

Slide 56 As you reread the 2nd chapter of the Gospel of Luke, you will find answers.

The story of their life enlightens us and gives us paths to follow.
